
And the Award Goes to....

Once again 4 Kids and Community was awarded funds from Stillwater Area United Way! New fund amounts begin this month. 4 Kids received a \$2,000 matching grant from the Perkins Masonic Lodge for the Baked Potato Fundraiser. During Holy Week Services, the offering collected, \$2,350, was donated to 4 Kids food program. In September, 4 Kids applied and won a grant from a local non-profit Kickin' Childhood Hunger. Total amount awarded: \$12,500 to help with snacks program and the food program. Perkins Lions Club raised over \$1,800 for the food program



A Note from Program Director:

2016 was a wonderful year! 4 Kids' board of directors added three cooking classes, rolled out supply closets for every school, increased students receiving snacks each day, provided leadership for Meadows of Hope's foster parent monthly training meetings, increased the number of parents participating in the school supply program, added more grades to receive testing snacks, filled art teacher's supplies for class, provided more food boxes to families and weekend food bags to the older students and so much more. The board also evaluated, restructured and renamed many programs to help serve the schools and community better. We accomplished a lot in 2016, but we will not rest! We are always looking for ways to improve the

way we serve. In 2017 we are looking forward to do more for the schools and for the people in the community. Thank you for supporting us! One last thing, in November Sheila Farmer, my mother, created 4 Our Community in Luther. 4 Kids and Community cannot go into other communities, but we can inspire and provide wisdom for others to succeed!
