January 7th was our monthly board meeting, the theme was celebrate as we went through the many blessings that happened in 2019. We hope you enjoy the review. Thank you for your continue support. We appreciate you!

### **Working Together**


- During the summer, the adults at the Life Adult Day Healthcare Center packs the weekend food bags for all for schools. They packed 75 weekend food bags.
- The high school cheerleaders help unload, pack and distribute four summer food boxes for our families.
- This summer we were able to find a new home old learning centers materials: a school in Belize. We were able to repurpose the items.
- 4. During the school year, the high school FFA classes help unload and pack the food boxes. We purchase Blue and Gold items for the boxes through the group.
- Every month throughout the school year, the High School FCCLA classes packs and distributes enough snack packs to feed approximately 350 students each school day.
- Every five weeks during school year, Middle School FCCLA classes pack the weekend food bags for the middle school and high school. Between 15 to 20 students each week receives a food bag.
- 7. Every month, individuals, organizations, churches, farms, churches, businesses donate food and time to make Community Supper a success.
- Partnering with Rockin' Cowboy church 21 families received a Thanksgiving meal and breakfast/lunch boxes.
- Partnering with Perkins First United Methodist Church, over 40 shut-ins received a hot meal during the November's Community Supper.
- 4 Kids partnered with Perkins Lions Club, Dollar General, McDonald's, Payne County Bank, University & Community Credit Union, First Baptist Church Sunday School Class and many individuals to provide gifts for children.

- 4 Kids partnered with the middle school's FCCLA class to provide 39 fleece blankets for Christmas boxes.
- Partnering with Church of Christ, they provided over 40 food boxes to go with the Christmas boxes and did the distribution and delivery.
- 13. 4 Kids provided 99 hygiene kits and 19 art kits for the Christmas boxes.
- 14. A member of Church of Christ donated 15 quilts to our families.
- 15. Sorghum Mill Tree Farm donated a Christmas tree to one of our families.
- 16. With Perkins Community Chamber of Commerce, 55 children shopped at the Children's Christmas Shoppe! Special thanks to Ashton and Sutton for the many hours of sorting and packaging the items, and Benchmark Animal Hospital for the storage area! Thank you Affirmative Business Solutions for creating, printing, and distributing the flyers!
